Update Report of the Sojourner Truth Memorial Statue Committee — September 2002

Statue To Be Unveiled October 6

The Sojourner Truth Memorial Statue will be unveiled in an afternoon dedication ceremony on Sunday, October 6, at 1:30 p.m., rain or shine, at the corner of Pine and Park Streets in Florence. The public is invited.

The program will include brief remarks about the life of Sojourner Truth in Florence and the grassroots community effort, begun almost ten years ago, to create the memorial. The Florence Community Band will perform before and after the ceremony. Additional musical selections will be performed by Joyful Noise Gospel Choir.

Sculptor Thomas Jay Warren will be introduced. Other special guests will include: the Northampton landscape architect firm of Denig Design Associates, which created and donated the memorial design; Senator Stan Rosenberg, whose leadership won a \$100,000 state grant for the memorial; and Mayor Mary Clare Higgins.

Guests are encouraged to bring a lawn chair or blanket, as limited seating will be provided, and to walk, bicycle, or carpool. Limited parking is available behind the Florence Community Center.

Walking History Tour of Florence

Florence resident Paul Gaffney will lead a walking history tour of the neighborhood where Sojourner Truth lived in the 1840s and 1850s. The tour, on October 6, will begin at the Sojourner Truth Memorial, at approximately 2:30, immediately following the dedication ceremony. Gaffney is Professor of Humanities at Landmark College and President of the Florence Association. A contribution of \$5 is requested.

This tour will last about 1 1/4 hours and include the Park Street cemetery; historical residences on Park & Pine Streets; and the Nonotuck Street site of the Northampton Association of Education and Industry, the utopian community of which Truth was a member. Tour participants will learn about the recent research which strongly suggests that Truth's house at 35 Park Street still stands. For more information please contact Monica Green at 585-1010.
